

## Know Your SHAPE Summary

- ✓ **Spiritual Gifts** What are your spiritual gifts?
  - Discernment, evangelism, exhortation / encouragement, prophecy, teaching, tongues, interpretation of tongues, Word of Knowledge, wisdom, faith, giving, healing, administration / leadership, miracles, helps / service, & mercy.
- ✓ Heart What do you have a passion for?
  - Causes (recovery, spiritual growth, human trafficking, etc.)
  - People (children, married couples, men, women, singles, poor, etc.)
  - Roles (discipleship, negotiate, design / developer, etc.).
- ✓ Abilities What are some of your abilities? What can you do well?
  - Planning, organizing, designing, computers, music, etc.
- ✓ **Personality** What trait fits you the best? Are you ...
  - Extroverted or Introverted?
  - Thinker or Feeler?
  - Routine or Variety?
  - Cooperative or Competitive?
- ✓ Experience What is your experience in the following areas?

# Spiritual Gifts

"Now there are different kinds of Spirituals Gifts, but it is the Holy Spirit that is the source of them all." 1 Corinthians 12:4 NLT

### "SPEAKING" GIFTS:

**DISCERNMENT (or DISTINGUISHING) OF SPIRITS** - The ability to intuitively discern if another's words, actions, motives or plans are of God or are from another (satanic or merely human) source. The ability to easily "see through" people and their facades. Likely manifested as frequent, strong hunches about the "rightness" or "wrongness" of people and actions, from <u>God's</u> perspective.

**EVANGELISM** - It is uncertain, biblically, if this is really a separate, discernable gift. It may be better understood as a <u>vocation</u> ("evangelist") adopted by a person with other speaking or serving gifts. If understood as a gift, it is probably manifested as a deep concern about people's need for Christ and a compelling desire to tell them about Him. It enables an intuitive alertness to good opportunities for sharing and an ability (especially with practice) to communicate the gospel simply, clearly, effectively, with conviction and with sensitivity to the feelings and needs of the listener.

Note: A few with this gift may also sense the Lord's urging to devote themselves full-time to reaching others for Christ as a missionary or church-planter. These are likely the modern-day "equivalents" of the New Testament apostles in that they fulfill much the same function and possess the same sense of being "sent."

**EXHORTATION** - The marked ability to drive home specific truths from God's Word, to help others recognize God's will for their lives, and to point out practical areas of lack or disobedience. Manifested as a frequently-experienced inclination to challenge, advise, stir up, motivate, change, fix, reassure or encourage others forward.

**PROPHECY** - Manifested as an inner urging to speak out God's word; to crisply, practically, directly, authoritatively and lovingly address specific needs, faults or lacks in others so that their hearts are penetrated and they are challenged, encouraged or built up as a result.

**TEACHING** - Manifested as (1) a keen desire to study God's word, (2) the ability to dig down to its meaning and relevance, and (3) the inner urging to organize and explain clearly to others what was learned so they can profit from it, also.

Note: A few with this gift may also sense the Lord's urging to assume general responsibility for the spiritual well-being of a group, serving in the office/ministry of a "*pastor*-teacher." Some who are uniquely enabled to relate God's truth to people's needs in a piercingly relevant manner may be said to possess the modern day "equivalent" of the prophetic gift.

**TONGUES** - The overflow of a heart filled with gratitude, love and praise to God, naturally spilling out through the mouth in unintelligible language (whether in prayer, song or declaration).

**INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES** - The ability to understand with *certainty* the meaning of what has been prayed, sung or declared in "tongues."

**WORD OF KNOWLEDGE** - The ability to come up with a timely scripture, insight, answer, point, definition or explanation from God in response to a specific question or need for truth / counsel.

**WORD OF WISDOM** - The ability to come up with a helpful insight or solution, from the Scriptures, experience or common sense, in response to specific needs for guidance, advice or practical help with a decision or problem.

### "SERVING" GIFTS:

**FAITH** - The ability to (1) peacefully continue to trust God and to maintain courage and endurance in times of difficulty or stress, (2) confidently expect God to act in response to needs and petitions, and (3) envision large, progressive things which God would like to do in the future.

**GIVING** - Manifested as (1) a heightened alertness to the financial or material needs of Christian individuals and organizations, (2) a strong desire to help meet those needs, and (3) a special sense of joy and fulfillment in regularly doing so.

**HEALINGS** - The ability to serve as a human intermediary through whom God cures and restores health or wholeness to others. Likely manifested as an inner urging to touch or pray for others in need with the confidence that God desires (or would be willing) to heal them.

**LEADING / ADMINISTRATION -** A unique desire and ability to see the big picture, focus on a vision, set objectives, shoulder responsibility, assume authority, work out plans, organize, coordinate, make decisions, delegate, supervise, direct, manage and see that objectives are reached and tasks are accomplished for Jesus' sake.

**MIRACLES** - The ability to serve as a human intermediary through whom God performs acts of power which defy the "laws" of nature or overcome some satanic / demonic influence. Likely manifested as (1) a periodic, heightened alertness to situations in which God desires (or would be willing) to personally intervene, and (2) an inner urging to take charge of the situation on His behalf.

**SERVING** / **HELPING** - Manifested as (1) an alertness to different kinds of practical chores and tasks needing attention, (2) the inward readiness and desire to take care of them, and (3) a marked sense of fulfillment and joy in doing so for Jesus' sake.

**(SHOWING) MERCY** - Manifested as (1) a heightened alertness and sensitivity to the needs of others in some kind of distress, (2) a deep feeling of compassion and concern in response, and (3) an inward urging to be available and to act on their behalf in whatever way is necessary to <u>relieve</u> their distress.


# Personality distinctives

#### 1. WHERE YOU GET YOUR "ENERGY":





#### 3. EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCES.


